PRESIDENT'S REPORT 2020 -2021 SEASON

The past 2020/2021 season has been both interesting and challenging. It has seen the Club undertake the following:

- 1. Host its annual Wimbledon White fundraiser November 2020 a fantastic evening raising approximately \$20,000 for the Club;
- 2. Host the annual Fast-Four tennis tournament organised by Martin Colenbrander which was a huge success;
- 3. Install a new concertina window system upstairs allowing open air viewing of the courts by members / visitors;
- 4. Replace old drinks fridge for the adults area with new double door fridge;
- 5. Install new lockers for use by members and visitors outside the bathrooms on the basement level of the club; and
- 6. Undertake much needed maintenance around the club including clearing the drains which run under the tennis courts.

We have also had to close the Club for a period of time, due to the Level 4 Covid lock down twice, in August–September 2020 and then again in February–March 2021.

OUR CLUB SPIRIT

The Club remains in very good heart and is a happy and friendly place to play tennis and socialise. This is largely due to efforts of the Management Committee – (each of which has their own area of activity to focus on), the Head Coach (and his coaching team) and other volunteers who positively contribute to Club activities through out the season.

The Club is also in a good financial position after undertaking a number of expensive capital projects.



As a result we are able to hold the membership fees for the 2021/2024 year at the same level as the **past 4 seasons**. This continues to make us one of the best value Clubs in the area.
